- Activity: Equity vs. Equality watch the following videos: (go to YouTube and search for the title, "Equity Vs Equality" 4:30 video and search for "Fair is Fair Read Aloud" 5: 40 video)
- Something to think/talk about: What is equal? What is fair? How do you experience this at home, within the family, within the community? How can you work for more equity in the world?
- Closing Prayer: Heavenly Father, Heavenly Mother, help us show love and kindness to all, regardless of their station in life. Amen.

#### Week of November 20

- Opening Prayer: Dear Jesus, in your name, please help us to do right by others and everyone you bring into our lives. Amen.
- **Scripture:** Luke 9: 16-17
- Something to think/talk about: Research ethnic and cultural people groups different from your own that have restaurants or groceries in the area. What foods to they eat? What is the same about the food? What is different?
- Activity: Restaurant (or Shopping) Rotation Eat or shop for groceries at places from communities that are not like your own. Try new food at the restaurant.
- Closing Prayer: Lord's Prayer

## Week of November 27

- **Opening Prayer:** Creator God, thank you for the unique and perfect way you created the world and all that is in it. Your works are wondrous! Amen.

- Activity: Letter to the Editor think about a justice issue your family is passionate about. Take your local newspaper together. See if you can find an article that talks about the justice issue that you're passionate about. If you find an article about it, write a letter to the editor thanking them for including something your passionate about. If you don't find an article, write a letter to the editor telling them why you are passionate about the justice issue and ask them to include it in their coverage.
- Closing Prayer: God, may your extraordinary love flow through us in ordinary ways. Amen.
